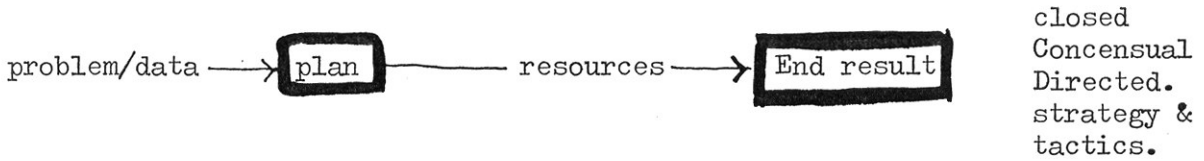

Lecture 8. Paradigms of Change

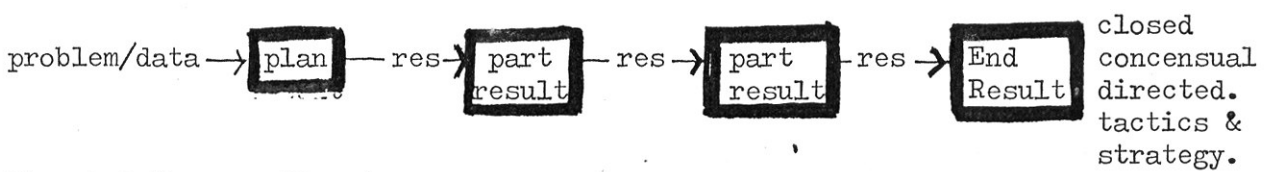
Planning as an activity may usefully be examined on the following points:

- How directive is the plan in strategic and tactical terms.

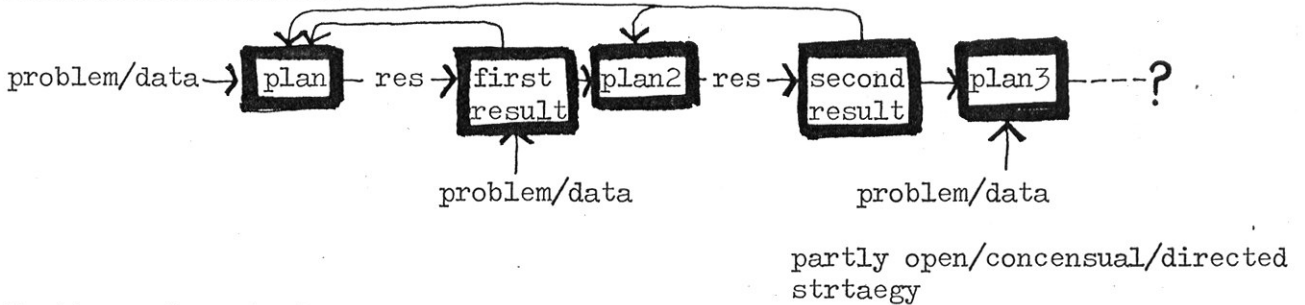
End-State Planning
